



STATEMENT OF PARENT OR GUARDIAN

I UNDERSTAND AND ENDORSE THE FOLLOWING:

- ❖ That my child's growth and development must be a cooperative effort of the home and school. Therefore, I will consistently reinforce the school's discipline and training efforts in the home and will give my support through participation in its programs and projects and parent/teacher conferences or meetings.
- ❖ The Victory Christian Academy operates on the power of love, the Principles of Christ, the guidance of the Holy Spirit, and the discipline of the Scriptures. The Academy staff has full discretion in the guidance and discipline of my child, based on Bible principles.
- ❖ That the school program, its budget, staff and curriculum is organized and developed as a full-term operation and is part of the Ministry of the Victory Church of God. I will endeavor to meet my financial responsibility in supporting this ministry.
- ❖ That the school will utilize professional methods and Christian love in the teaching of my child. I give the school staff full authority for the grouping and grade placement of my child.
- ❖ That the school will provide some off-campus learning experiences (field trips) as well as a variety of on-campus activities and will not hold the school liable (above school insurance, which in no way is meant to replace your own personal medical coverage) in case of injury to me or my child during such activities, or regular day to day school operations.
- ❖ That the school is concerned about the whole person. I will provide any health or medical information which contribute to a better understanding of my child. The school has permission to administer general household medications and first aid in cases of health emergencies, unless I have noted exceptions in the margin at the bottom of this page.
- ❖ That every effort will be made to lead students to be happy and comfortable with the Victory Christian Academy life style. If, however, there should be a rare case where a student cannot be guided to function in harmony with the policies of the school, the school administration has the full authority to make the decision regarding dismissal of the student.
